The APC Clinical Learning Series was developed to support the IM/FM teaming strategy. The Academic Institute provides coordination and logistical support.

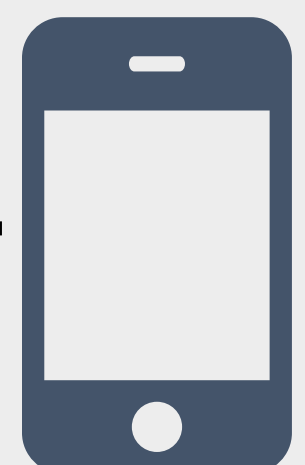
Goals of the APC Clinical Learning Series:

- Develop skills and knowledge for efficient clinical practice
- Promote community and mentorship among clinicians

METHODS

- Program is required for all new hire APCs with less than 2 years relevant experience
- Didactic sessions include lectures and case study discussions
- Sessions are taught by clinical and operational leaders of Atrius Health

The APC Clinical Learning Series has trained 66 newly hired APCs since 2020. The program has been instrumental in equipping this community of clinicians to successfully support our patients.

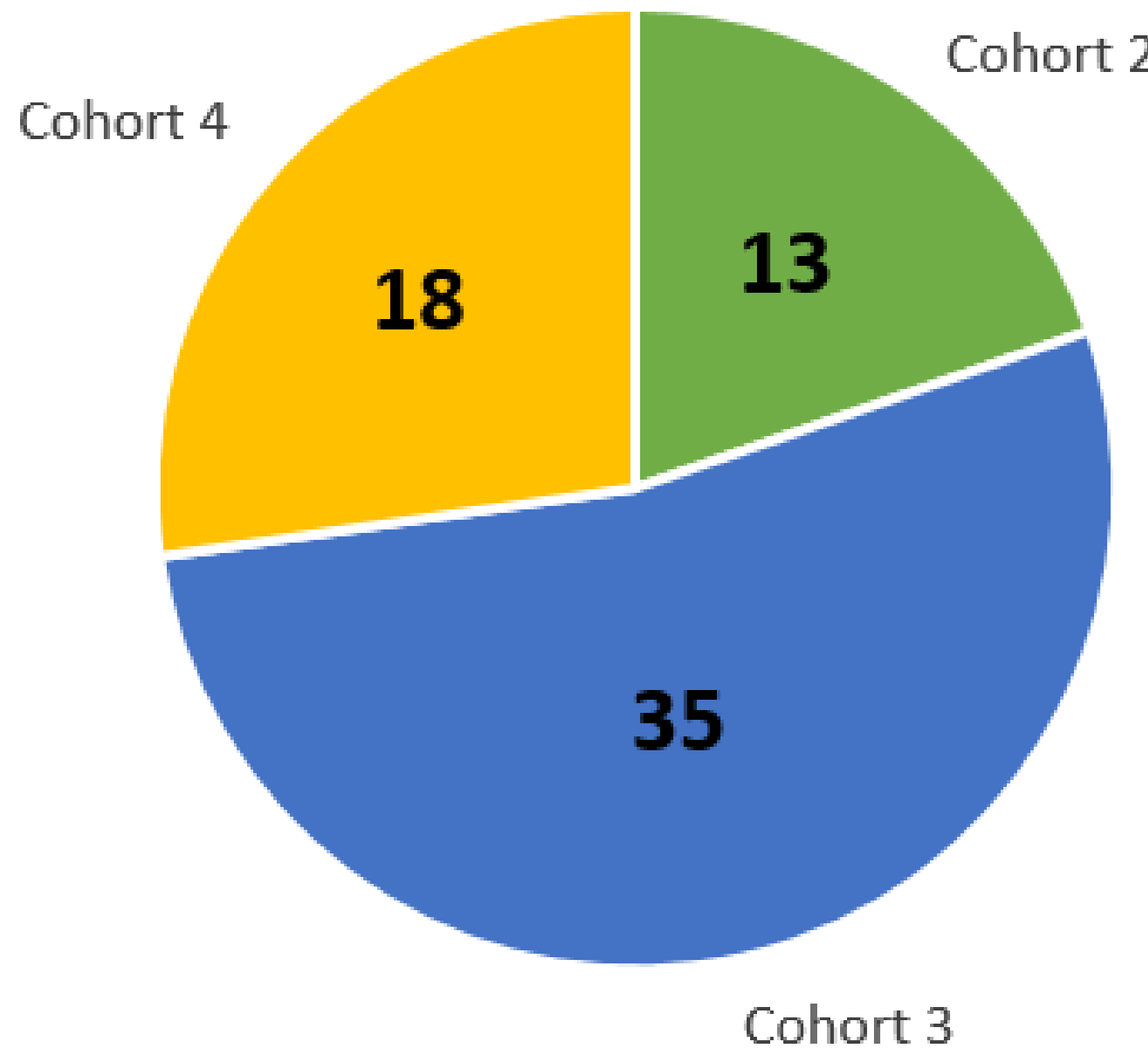


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RESULTS
