

Atrius Health Sponsored Home Health Device Distribution Program



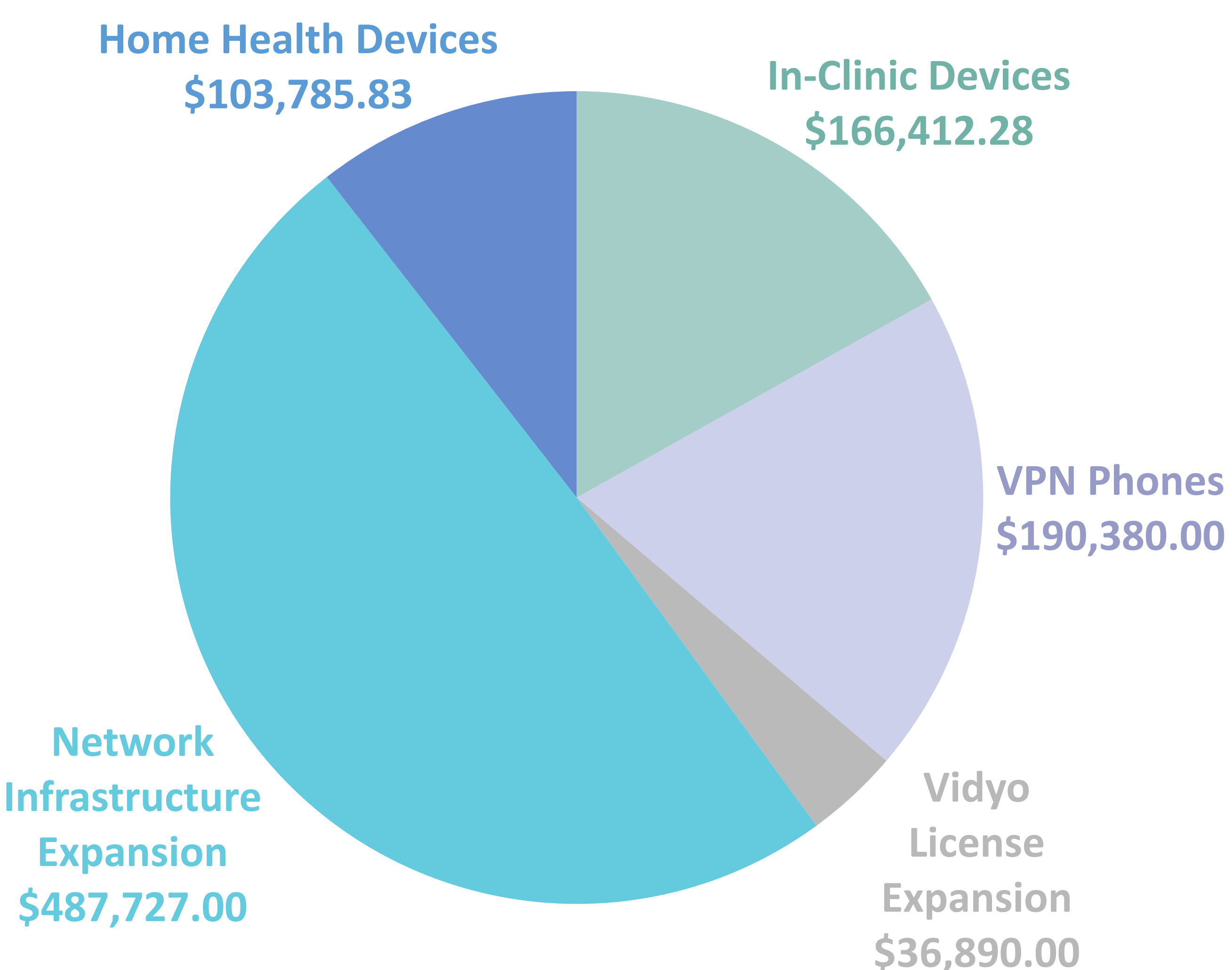
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The **Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act** created funding avenues for healthcare companies tackling the challenge of continuing to provide care while adhering to physical distancing protocols.

Atrius Health was awarded \$985,312 to accomplish the following goals:

1. Immediately increase telemedicine capacity, allowing more patients to receive care remotely
2. **Create a sustainable program for distributing home health monitoring devices to patients**

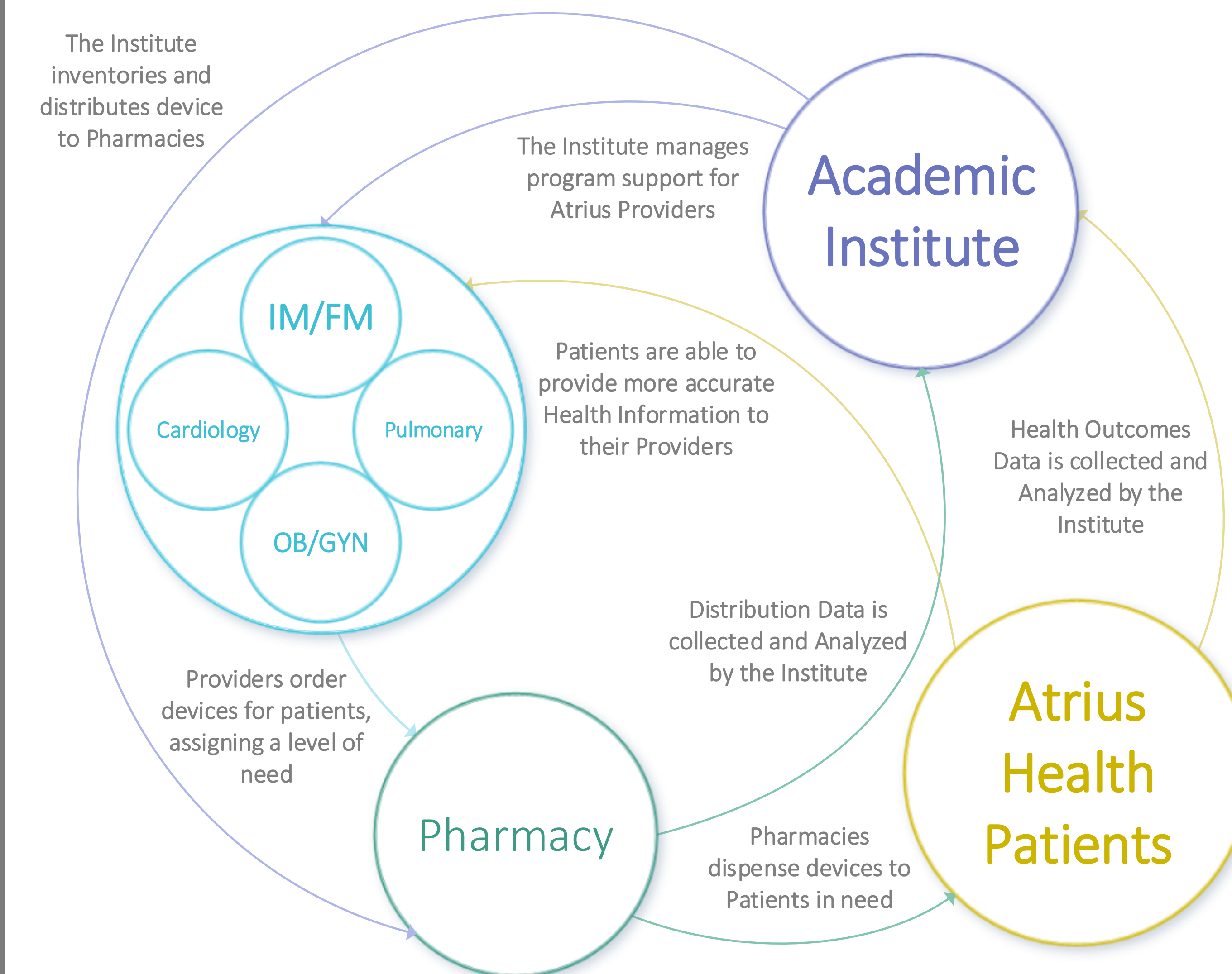
CARES ACT FUNDING ALLOCATION



The Academic Institute secured Federal grant enabling a substantial hardware investment in our digital health infrastructure

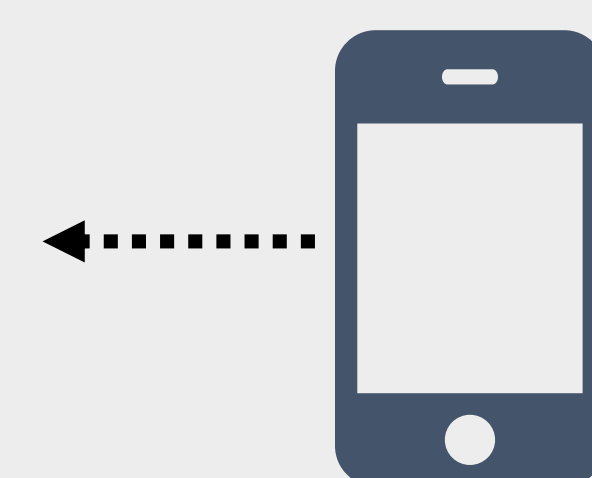
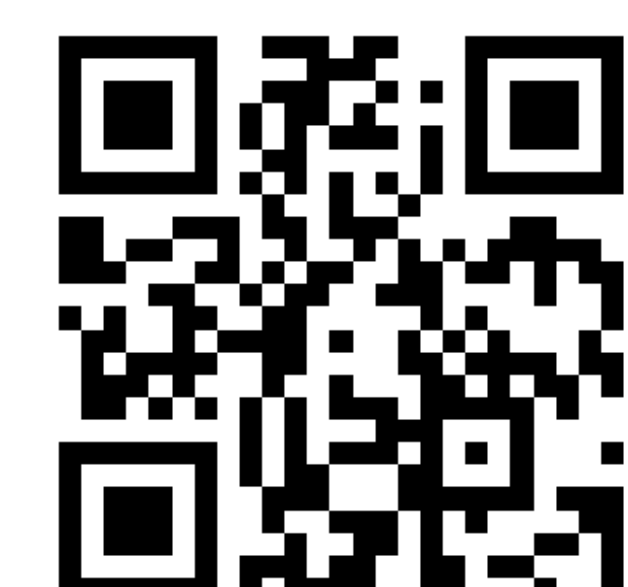
A multidisciplinary working group designed the distribution, workflow and evaluation strategy

The impact assessment of the hardware investment on patient health and workflows is forthcoming



With over \$100k in funding for Home Health Devices, the Academic Institute began a collaboration with Atrius Health's Pharmacy Department, Internal Medicine, and several key specialties to implement a distribution program to achieve several important goals

Goal	Strategy
Ensure Broad Accessibility to the devices	Team with the Atrius Health Facilities Department to distribute inventory to Pharmacies across the organization
Ensure that patients with the Highest Risk factors are prioritized	Build an ordering system that allows providers to communicate a patient's level of risk to the dispensing pharmacist
Leverage distribution data to explore related health outcomes and inform the rollout of similar programs in the future	Incorporate a tracking mechanism in the ordering system that allows device distribution to be link to medical records for future evaluation and analysis



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
